Remember there are 4 forms that need to be filled out. They are listed on the web site. All forms must be sent in by September 9th. For players trying out for travel teams the forms must be sent in before tryouts. Someone will be at the Midget Tryouts this weekend to collect the forms and payment.

For those people that pre registered I would first like to say thanks from the board. We had a very high percentage of people pre register. This provided much needed information for determining how many skaters would be in each program and what the 2006-2007 programs would be. Second if you did pre

register and pay the \$50 pre registration fee please be sure to note that on the other section under payment.

One change for this year is that USA Hockey is requiring a parent education class. Information including times for this class are listed under the registration section of the web site. This is a mandatory class. At least one person from each family must attend prior to playing games. Players will not be allowed to participate in games until this requirement has been fulfilled.
