Ithaca Youth Hockey Association (IYHA) Hockey Registration Form

Registration for the 2006-2007 Youth Hockey Season
(Not for Initiation or Mite players.)

Your IYHA Board of Directors would like to try something different and we need your help! As you might recall, last year we were scrambling right up to the last minute to declare teams for the various commitment levels of play in each age group. It was an unpleasant situation. Although we made the best of it, we would rather not repeat the frustration levels many people experienced. To better assist us in providing what your player and you want, we are asking you to immediately participate in registration for IYHA's 2006-2007 season.

Specifically, we want you to indicate what commitment level you would like to participate in. We recognize that some players might just want to play one level and have no interest in the other levels; however we need to gauge interest in the commitment levels that we can offer.

If one level is not available or your player is not selected for that level, what is the next level you would want to play?

To assist you, here is a general guideline/brief description of each commitment level:

Snowbelt:

Last year's prices;

Squirt \$475

PW \$595

Bantam \$595

Midget \$595

Approximate length of season: Last week of October to mid March

One practice a week, one to two games per weekend. Minimum of 20 league games (10 away/10 home), usually approximately 30 games. The number of practices per week and actual games will depend on each Snowbelt team and what they want. Equal ice time is mandatory for SB League games. The extra practices, if any, will be team (not IYHA) paid (same with tournaments.)

UNY:

Last year's prices;

Squirt \$950

PW \$990

Bantam \$990

Midget \$850

Approximate length of season: First week of October to mid March except for Midgets who play from the beginning of November to mid March.

Two practices a week, two games per weekend. The actual number of games and tournaments played will be dependant on what the team decides to do. Equal ice time is encouraged

Travel:

Last year's prices;

Squirt \$1,050

PW \$1,050

Bantam \$1,050

Midget \$610 (Half season)

Approximate length of season: End of September to first week of March except for Midgets who play from the beginning of September to the end of October.

Two practices, two games per week. Most IYHA Travel teams usually play approximately 45 games, including several tournaments.

For 2006-2007 Squirt Players:

We are also gauging interest in having another option for Squirt players.

This option (House) will consist of one practice and one game/scrimmage per

week. The possibility of a second practice and a "Taxi" type team will be dependant upon interest and ice availability. It is not anticipated that a Squirt House league will have as many teams as this year's Mite House league. In this case, the team(s) will scrimmage and an effort will be made to find some neighboring teams to play.

Please indicate the commitment level you would like to participate in. We recognize that some players might just want to play one level and have no interest in the other levels; however we need to gauge interest in the commitment levels that we can offer.

If one level is not available or your player is not selected for that level, what is the next level you would want to play?
